Children and Dental Emergencies

With the summer upon us, children are excited, care-free and looking forward to playing sports, or just with their family and friends; with this comes a higher risk of a dental emergency. There are some things to keep in mind when a dental incident occurs:

If a baby tooth has come out: Contact us, your dental office. If bleeding is present, rinse the mouth and place gauze where the tooth is missing, and ice on the outside of the mouth wrapped in a towel to reduce swelling. Stay calm and keep child calm. There is no need to search for the missing baby tooth.

If a permanent (adult) tooth has come out: Find the tooth and rinse gently under water only. Hold the tooth in the socket (not out of the mouth) with clean gauze, if not, keep the tooth in a container with your child's saliva or milk. Seek immediate dental care with your child's family dentist or emergency dentist.



If a tooth is chipped or fractured: If your child is experiencing any pain, contact us right away, this may save the tooth or prevent more extensive treatment. Rinse with water, apply ice to the outside of the mouth to reduce any inflammation.

Dental emergencies can often be avoided by ensuring that a custom-fit mouthguard is being worn during contact sports. Custom mouthguards need regular replacement as your child's teeth change position as they grow.

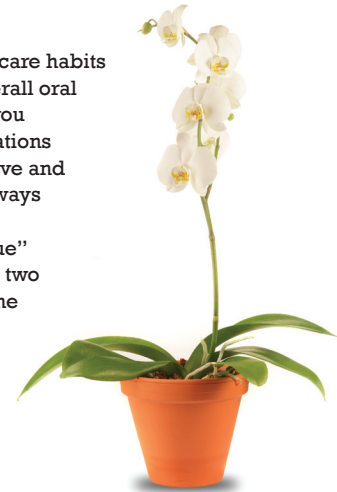
WaterPik vs. AirFloss: WHAT is the Difference?

We often talk about the use of WaterPik (aka. WaterFloss) and AirFloss with some of our patients who have braces, dental implants, or restorations that are difficult to floss around, or for patients who just dislike flossing and are looking for another alternative. Truthfully, there is no alternative to mechanical, interdental cleaning such as floss or a soft tool designed to clean between your teeth, however, both of these units are great in conjunction. Interdental cleaning with floss is still the gold-standard in plaque removal in between your teeth.



When we review your current homecare habits and assess your gum health and overall oral health, we promise to always keep you informed, and to make recommendations based on our findings to help improve and maintain your oral health. We are always keeping current with the latest, the trendiest and the most "tried and true" tools to help our patients. There are two tools that we are often discussing: The WaterPik vs. AirFloss.

The AirFloss uses microbursts of air to clean between the teeth, similar to when we dry the teeth with air at the dental office. This is an attractive tool to some because it is cordless and isn't as "messy" because it uses air instead of water.

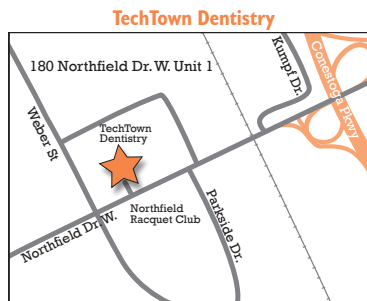

The WaterPik uses pressured water to clean around and in between the teeth. The WaterPik has different pressure settings and is effective around braces, dental implants and difficult to clean restorations such as bridgework.

In our opinion, the WaterPik is a more effective tool as it removes more plaque bacteria with the use of pressured water, therefore the gums respond better. The Air-Floss cannot remove as much plaque bacteria, as plaque can become "sticky" on the teeth and this would just create a drier oral environment, with less removal of the "sticky" plaque bacteria.
